

Inclusive Education Support Program—Funding Processes for Term 1 and 2 2019

From term 1 2019, **students requiring less than 4 hours of support per week** will access support provided via the **site's IESP grant**

Note: this includes those students who would be verified under existing DSP criteria but require adjustments less than 4 hours per week. SSS involvement will be encouraged with sites to provide support with determining the types of interventions required for this cohort.

Students already included in the DSP requiring additional resourcing —mainstream

Students who are currently included in the DSP and are allocated a level of support will be translated to one of the new funding categories 1-9



If the level of adjustment is found to be insufficient, use current processes and forms to submit an application to the I, H or V panels in terms 1 and 2 2019. Panel will assign a new funding 1-9 category



New funding category will automatically be continued in term 3 2019 and will only end at the time of the specified review date

Students newly being considered for additional resourcing - eligible under DSP criteria

Students who would be eligible for inclusion using the DSP criteria



Student to be allocated a category 1, 2, or 3 by Student Support Services



If a higher level of adjustment is required— use current processes and forms for submitting application to I, H or V panels. Panel will assign a new funding 1-9 category



Funding category will automatically be continued in term 3 2019 and will only end at the time of the specified review date

Students newly being considered for additional resourcing - not eligible under DSP criteria

Students who would NOT be eligible for inclusion using the DSP criteria but would have been eligible for other short term resourcing (e.g. behaviour, DSF for medical) and the adjustment required is for 4 hours per week or more



Student to be allocated a SHORT TERM category 1, 2, or 3 by Student Support Services.
(Max 2 terms)



An application using the new IESP criteria will need to be submitted to the centralised panel in term 3 2019

Students already included in the DSP requiring additional resourcing —special options

Site complete RAAP using current form and submit to DPP email: education.DPP@sa.gov.au
Short term category 1-3 funding not be accessed by Special Options students



Application will be reviewed by the 'Intensive Personalised Curriculum / Challenging Behaviour Panel' - advice given to RAAP



RAAP reviews and communicates outcome.
